

Rescue Dogs Pose in Regal Hats– Including One Fit for a Queen!

The dog days of summer may be over, but fall is kicking off in glam-pup style with the release of the 2023 Haute Dogs Calendar, which raises funds for Thailand-based charity Jai Dog Rescue. The new edition features 13 former stray dogs—rescued and rehabilitated by the organization—wearing bespoke designer headwear from some of the world's most famous milliners, including London's Awon Golding, who organizes the annual project, and Rachel Trevor-Morgan, a hatmaker to the Queen who created a tiny tiara for June 2023 modeled by pup Jai Dee. Golding started the project five years ago to help dogs who've suffered abuse and neglect before arriving at rescues and being placed for adoption. "Thankfully, this neglect is equally matched by the love and generosity of our supporters," she says, adding that to date, nearly \$60,000 has been raised for the organizations she has partnered with. The calendars are available for preorder through Sept. 30 at hautedogscalendar.com—and in a fun twist, the hats featured will go up for auction this November.
